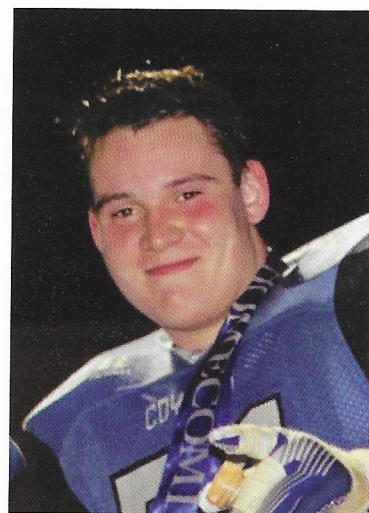
Our prayers continue to be with our family and friends as we venture through 2023.

Ways We Give - Highlights

Since our inception, the Patrick Shifflett Foundation has been able to donate or award a total of \$332,675 in Patrick's name. Here are some of the deserving organizations we gave to this year:

Childhelp

We were proud to support Childhelp, a program that through treatment, prevention and intervention changes the lives of children who have been harmed and abused by shaping their futures, filling them with harmony and love.

The Children's Inn at NIH

The Inn is a residential facility that allows families with seriously ill children to stay free of charge while participating in research at NIH. Like our Foundation, their aim is to ease the burdens of those in less fortunate situations – in this case, providing a "place like home" for families facing the stresses of their child's health.

Christmas Giving

On December 21st the Foundation continued our Christmas tradition of adopting several families in the local community who were in need of gifts for their children and dinner on their tables. Families were given a Christmas meal, presents for their children, and a large bin full of groceries for the holiday break.

Clarksburg Baseball & Softball

We continue to sponsor Clarksburg baseball and softball teams to give our younger players an opportunity to play the game they love.

The EVAN Foundation

We partnered with the 18U Crush/CHS Softball Team for a December toy drive by donating \$1,000. The girls collected and shopped for toys benefiting kids undergoing cancer treatments at 3 local Children's National Hospital Oncology Unit locations. On Dec. 21st, the Evan Foundation filled multiple "treats and treasures" carts and wheeled them out to cancer patients. Over 150 toys and candy treats were collected and distributed through this partnership.



Food Drive

For the 3rd year in a row, we collected canned foods at the Safeway in Damascus in early November, allowing us to fill many bins in our holiday giving programs. A special thank you to Ed Tippet for making this possible.

Leukemia Lymphoma Society

We continued our support of the Coyotes for a Cure legacy by making donations to Bella Bragg and Anthony Zinzi. Bella became a candidate for the LLS Student of the Year by raising over \$26,000 and leading the team into the top 10. The team as a whole raised nearly \$170,000 and was the

only public high school to do that in the program's history.

MCPS Coat Drive

As winter approached, we decided to support a Montgomery County Public Schools program to donate 100 coats to help keep elementary school students in need warm this winter.

St. Jude Children's Research Hospital

With a goal to cure childhood cancer, St. Jude's mission is to advance cures and means of prevention for pediatric catastrophic diseases. No child is denied treatment based on a family's ability to pay.

Thanksgiving Meals

On November 22, 2022, we continued our Thanksgiving Giving Program. We adopted several local families that were given an amazing Thanksgiving meal along with all the fixings and a bin full of staples to fill the families' pantries for the long holiday weekend.

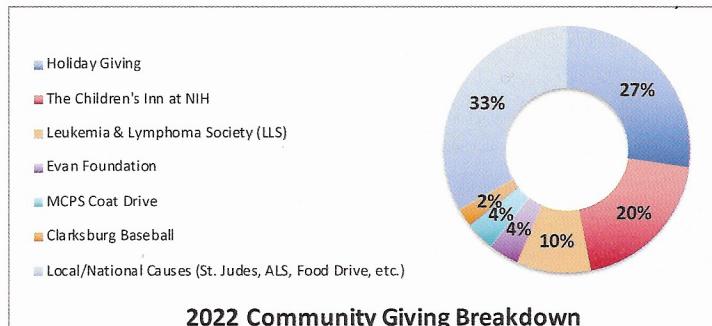
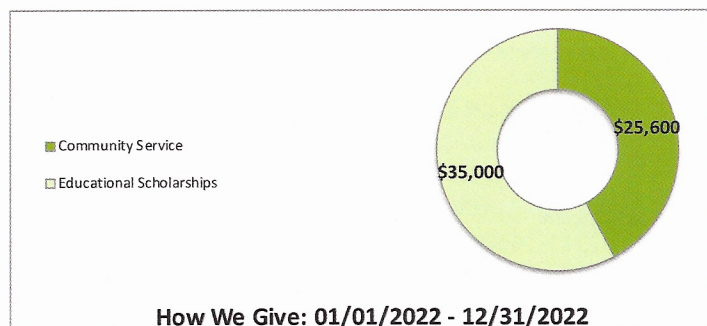
Walk to Defeat ALS

Year End 2022 (Note the Foundation is a Private 501(c)3 charitable organization)

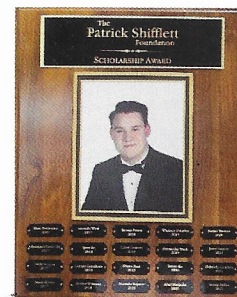


Scholarships
